Los Angeles & National

MARKET INSIGHTS

NATIONAL / U.S. CONSTRUCTION OUTLOOK

- The U.S. construction sector is facing headwinds: overall activity is down ~13 % year-over-year, driven by inflation, interest rates, and supply constraints.
- Material prices are becoming a critical variable. For example, common diameters of copper pipe are up by 40%, and copper wire has risen 14–17% this year.
- On the upside: growth in public-sector spending, infrastructure, data centers, and specialized facilities remains a stabilizing force in many regions.

CALIFORNIA & LOCAL CONTEXT

- In California, education construction spending is projected to remain flat, though voter-approved bond measures (~\$59 billion) may catalyze new opportunities.
- For Los Angeles County, GDP growth is forecast around 2.1% in 2025, with a modest slowdown in 2026 to 1.3%.
- Locally, many developers and homeowners are reporting slower permitting and cautious timing, as some projects are deferred or scaled back.



WHAT THIS MEANS FOR YOU:

- Budget volatility is real. It's smart to lock in key materials where possible and allocate contingencies for copper, wiring, and electrical systems.
- Large scale speculative builds face risk in this climate; custom homes and thoughtful renovations remain a safer bet.
- Keep an eye on public funding initiatives and infrastructure plans — these often drive indirect value to nearby residential projects.

Design Trends & Smart Guidance

EARTHY & LAYERED PALETTES

Designers are embracing warm neutrals—rust, terracotta, olive, and clay tones—to bring depth and comfort to spaces. The goal is spaces that feel timeless, layered, and emotionally grounded.



MATERIAL DRENCHING

One material dominates the visual narrative: wood, plaster, concrete, or textile. Rooms are designed around a singular tactile theme that feels immersive.



ENGLISH-STYLE KITCHENS & RANGE ALCOVES

Storied elements return: large range alcoves, ribboned molding, natural stone backsplashes, rich wood tones, and historically inspired palettes.



TEXTURED SURFACES & CEILINGS

Moss greens, rustic woods, floral softness. Together, they create bold yet balanced interiors.



“QUIET LUXURY” WITH CHARACTER

A new evolution of understated luxury: muted yet richly layered color, soft lighting, quality materials, and signature details rather than statement bling.



What to Look Out For When Building or Renovating

MATERIAL HEDGING

With copper and other electricals rising sharply, consider specifying alternatives or pre-purchasing for critical runs.

FLEXIBLE LAYOUTS

Given the dynamic market, design your home to adapt — guest spaces, work niches, convertible rooms.

SUSTAINABILITY + RESILIENCE

Stakeholder surveys show 87% believe we need to ramp up sustainable construction practices.

ARCHITECTURAL INTENT + AI

Architects are exploring AI to help generate concept layouts, but critical design sensibility and spatial judgment remain human.

PERMITTING STRATEGY

Start early. Engage with local planning agencies, understand overlays, and align designs to municipal guidance to avoid delay.
